Coupons for Classroom

Once again we will sell Coupons for Classroom books in our schools, starting in September. Books will be sold for \$25.00 each. The Campaign will begin September 8, 2016 and will last 4 weeks. Although last year this program raised over \$70,000 for our schools, this was down from \$85,000 the previous year. To make the program more attractive, each school now retains \$10 per book, up from \$8 and we have added more coupons from local businesses. We have also partnered with the St Lucie County Fair as our lead coupon page. Most of our students attend the County Fair and families can save money by buying the book.

The Education Foundation will begin school visits starting in August. Prizes will be awarded to students.
